Financial Secretary Report

Brother Knights,

The Knights of Columbus use a fraternal year that begins on July 1st and ends June 30th of the following year. We are now at the start of the 2025 – 2026 year. It is time to think about what is required to become a Star Council again. While qualifying for the Columbian Award is a matter of documenting the ordinary actives of the council, the Star Council award requires the recruitment of 15 new members. This has been a problem in the past. Recruitment is important to keep the council alive and well. We have 301 members. Half of those members are over 72 including 59 over 80 and 25 over 90. The average age of the members recruited last year is 48. We need continued recruitment to replace members who are no longer able to be actively involved in council activities. If you know of anyone who would be interested in becoming a member, please ask him to do so, they can join online by going to kofc.org and selecting the Join Us tab. Be sure to have them enter 4090 in the Preferred Council box and BLESSEDMCGIVNEY in the Promo Code box. Their first year will be free.

I hope everyone has had an amazing summer thus far. With the days starting to grow shorter, we are quickly approaching our annual MI Drive (Tootsie Roll Drive) event! For any of the new members: the KofC started the "Tootsie Roll Drive" in Chicago in the 1970s and it quickly grew to a nationwide fundraising event. Money raised from this event is directed at organizations that aid those with intellectual/developmental disabilities and assist in funding the Special Olympics.

Our council alone was able to raise \$10,139.90 last year! \$8,111.92 of which was distributed among 10 non-profit organizations in Genesee County directly aiding those with intellectual/developmental disabilities, and the remaining \$2027.98 used to help fund the annual Michigan Special Olympics at CMU. What an awesome way to spread the love of Christ all while created a positive impact within our community to help those less fortunate than ourselves! Last year our goal was \$10,000, and thanks to all those donating their time and prayers we made it! With enough volunteering this year, I am confident our council can collect \$15,000! We have the locations, vests, tootsie rolls, signage, refreshments, etc. All that is needed is time from every capable Brother to sign/show up to pass out tootsie rolls and collect donations. All family and friends of Brother members are welcome to volunteer to help make this worthy event a success as well.

This year the MI drive is **October 10th**, **11th**, **and 12th**. The sign-up boards are in the chambers of the 450 building. If you cannot make it to the chambers, feel free to contact myself or Greg McCarty at the information following to sign up. Time slots are in 2 hr. increments so please sign up for whatever you can. Refreshments and beverages will be available in the chambers every day of the event. Please keep the success of this event and all our Brother Knights in your prayers.
